Access

Building on its access to the transit system and its shopping, Fulton Street should be redesigned to better serve pedestrians. The sidewalks should be widened, leaving only enough roadway for emergency, delivery, and service vehicles.

The transit system should be celebrated rather than hidden. Entrances to the stations should be located prominently along the street rather than squeezed along its edge.

The typical width of the street is 53 feet. Redesign the street for pedestrians, keeping 12 feet along each side for walking and access to buildings and using half of the center for an emergency and service vehicle lane and the other half for access to the subway complex and for open air cafes.
